GENERAL INFORMATION:

**I am the third generation in sport of pure bred dogs. My grandfather used
to hunt with his sporting dogs in his native Spain (Irish Setters, Pointers,
And English Cocker Spaniels).**

**My Mother always had English Cockers and Labrador Retrievers at home,
and I grew up among them since I was born.**

**Our kennel name, EASTMAN’S has bred more than 130 Champions
worldwide in several breeds such as : Labrador Retrievers, Golden**

Retrievers, Scottish Terriers, Norwich Terriers, Norfolk Terriers, Sealyham Terriers, Afghan Hounds, Shar-Peis, Beagles, Drathaars, Whippets and Salukis.

We finished over 30 Labradors Retrievers in Chile, and many others won their titles all over South America, Multiple Specialty Winners and Group winners in several countries.

By 1996 I started to develop some interest in Terriers, and I bought my first show quality Scottish Terrier the same year.

I was very lucky to get a good specimen, so I won several BIS and Groups with my dog in a “basic” trim and grooming. No one taught me how to do it properly and there was no way to learn the techniques in my country at the time, so I spend every summer working for 3 month in the USA for different terrier handlers to improve my grooming and trimming skills with several different top Terrier Handlers.

Every year I try to go to Montgomery County . Also, I travel at least once a year to Europe to see and participate in some big shows like the Euro dog Show, or UK Championship Show.

In 2005, I went to Crufts with my Norwich Terrier dog and got Second at the competitive Open Class, being beaten only by the Best of Breed dog who was in the same class.

We also won the BIS at the Norwich Terrier Club Annual Show in Sweden, and we were Number one Norwich of the year in 2005. This Norwich won the breed at the Euro dog Show in Barcelona 2005, and was a multiple group winner in Spain, Portugal and Gibraltar the same year.

I have bred or own over 100 terrier Champions in the following countries: Sweden (1), Spain(2), Gibraltar (2), Portugal (1), France (2),Poland (1) USA (16 homebreds Scottish terriers, including winners at Specialties and Group Winners, Plus some Norfolks , Norwich and Sealyham terriers that keep representing the quality of our breeding program), Canada (1), Mexico (3), Cuba (1), Costa Rica (2), Colombia (5), Venezuela (3), Ecuador (3), Peru (5), Paraguay (6),Uruguay (7), Argentina (10), Brazil (2), Korea (1), Phillipines (1)Thailand(2) and of course Chile (45 or more) where I don't show as much because my involvement with the Kennel Club as a judge and active part of the Show Committee on the current Board.

I'm part of the founder group that started the first “ Terrier Club of Chile” which started on June 2018, and I was elected President of it for the very first period.

Some of my dogs, have reached the highest awards such as Best in Shows, Best in Specialty Shows (including the USA) and multiple group wins all over the World.

Currently I'm very focused on breeding Norfolk & Norwich Terriers, not leaving my Scotties and Sealys as they were my first breeds on the Terrier group.

Showing my dogs, I had the chance to show and win in countries like: USA, Canada, Mexico, Colombia, Venezuela, Ecuador, Brazil, Peru, Paraguay, Argentina, Uruguay, Spain, Gibraltar, Portugal, France, Holland, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Italy, India, Thailand, Singapore, Phillipines, Malaysia and The UK.

I have done grooming and trimming seminars named “How to groom and condition a Terrier for Show” in several countries as: Venezuela (invited by the “Merida Terrier Club”), Colombia (invited by the “Medellin Kennel Club”), Ecuador, and I have invitations to Asia for 2017-2018 depending on my schedule.

I was named and recognized judge for the Scottish Terrier Breed by the Chilean Kennel Club on 2008.(I was nominated as “Specialist judge for Scottish Terriers” due to the my work on this breed.)

Recognized as a Scottish Terrier Judge by FCI (Federation Cynologique Internationale , based on Belgium) at the beginning of 2009.

In 2009 I also gave and approve exams for Yorkshire terriers.

In 2010 I approve the exams for Cairn Terriers as well.

Now I´m recognized by the Chilean Kennel Club as a TERRIER GROUP judge (all terrier breeds recognized by FCI) since 2010.

On March 2012 I approved the Labrador retriever to become a Specialist judge on the breed, as well .

On 2013 the Kennel Club of Chile authorized me to judge the 8th Group under FCI system.

I´m approved to judge Miniature Schnautzers, Boxers and Dobermanns by FCI, and in 2017 I will be giving the exham for the complete Group 2.
